F. DIRECTORY LISTINGS

F.1 General

At regular intervals the Telephone Company issues an official directory which lists in alphabetical order the names of subscribers to its service. Issued by exchanges as adjuncts of the service, these directories remain the property of the Telephone Company. Extra or additional listings are available subject to rates and conditions stated hereunder.

F.2 Regular or primary Listings

F.2.1 Each subscriber is entitled to one regular listing for each main station telephone or private branch exchange trunk for which he is billed.

F.2.2 The directory listing does not necessarily have to agree with the name and form used in signing the contract but may be that of some other member of the same family, member of the firm, partner, trade name, tenant, employee or employer.

F.2.3 When a customer is entitled to more than one directory listing, such additional listing may be used to serve any of the conditions named below.

F.2.4 The responsibility for authority to use and list the names of persons, firms, and businesses other than his own must rest in the customer and no liability shall be attached to the Telephone Company for such listing.

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F.4 Miscellaneous Listings

F.4.1 Private Listings

F.4.1.1 A private listing shall be defined as a listing that is omitted from the telephone directory at the subscriber's written request. In no event shall the listing or number be given to the calling party by the Telephone Company or any of its employees.

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F.4 Miscellaneous Listings (Cont'd)

F.4.3 Dual Name Listings (Cont'd)

F.4.3.2 Dual name listings may be provided as the primary listing at no recurring charge for the addition of the second name to the listing.

F.5 Directory Listings and Joint User Service

F.5.1 The length of contract periods for directory listings, and for joint user service, where the listing actually appears in the directory is the directory period. The directory period is from the day on which the directory is first distributed to the customers to the day the succeeding directory is first distributed to the customers.

F.5.2 The length of contract period for directory listings and joint user service where the listing does not appear in the directory shall be one month. Such listings may be discontinued any time after the expiration of the initial contract period upon notification to the Telephone Company and prior to the closing date of the telephone directory. If notification of discontinuance of the listing or joint user service is not received by the Telephone Company prior to the directory closing date, the contract period shall be that of the new directory.

F.6 Telephone Directories

F.6.1 Distribution

The Telephone Company will furnish to its customers, without charge, only such directories as it deems necessary for the efficient use of the service. Other directories will be furnished at the discretion of the Telephone Company at a reasonable charge.

F.6.2 Ownership and Use

F.6.2.1 Directories regularly furnished to the customer are the property of the Telephone Company. The Telephone Company shall have the right to make a charge for directories issues in replacement of directories destroyed, defaced or mutilated while in the possession of the customer.

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F.6 Telephone Directories (Cont'd)

F.6.2 Ownership and Use (Cont'd)

F.6.2.2 Customers may only use with or attach to the directories furnished by the Telephone Company, binders, holders, inserts, auxiliary covers or attachments which are not so attached as to impede references to essential service information, or otherwise interfere with service. No other binders, holders, inserts, or auxiliary covers or attachments of any kind not furnished by the Telephone Company shall be attached to or used with directories furnished by the Telephone Company.

F.6.3 Errors and Omissions

F.6.3.1 The Telephone Company, except as provided herein, shall not be liable for damages claimed on account of errors in or omissions from its directories nor for the result of the publication of such errors in the directory, nor will the Telephone Company be a party to the controversies arising between customers or others for damages on account of interruptions to service due to errors or omissions in directory listings.

F.6.3.2 In the case of additional or joint user listings in the alphabetical section of the directory for which a charge is made, the Telephone Company's liability shall be limited to an amount not to exceed the established rate for such listings during the period which the error or omission continued.

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
